





The election of Archbishop Jeremy created a vacancy for a new Bishop for the Northern Region of our Diocese.

Following considerable prayer and with the concurrence of the Diocesan Council Archbishop Jeremy has announced that the Reverend Canon Sarah Plowman has accepted his invitation to be an Assistant Bishop in the Diocese of Brisbane and to serve as Bishop for the Northern Region.

Canon Sarah currently holds the position of Director of Discernment and Formation based at St Francis Theological College. Her current role is to carry oversight of those who are in training for Ordination as well as oversight of Clergy in their first three years of ministry.

Canon Sarah was ordained deacon in 2004 and priest in 2005.

Canon Sarah will be consecrated a Bishop of the Church of God at the Diocesan Synod Eucharist on Friday 21 June 2024, at 7.00pm.
